AGENDA: Plan to arrive at the scout hut at 6:00 PM Friday evening. If you arrive early you will not be allowed in until 6:00PM this will allow for the setup team to get everything ready. We will have pizza and drinks Friday night starting at 6:30 PM and doughnuts, juice and milk for breakfast Saturday. We will also provide drinks throughout the night. We will provide 20 laptop computers that run Windows XP and can run most video games and two projectors for displaying X-box or other gaming systems. Any game that requires Vista will not run on these machines. We will have a Local Area Network (LAN) setup for you to play multi-player games (no internet connectivity will be available). We will also provide several multi-player games for your use (Halo PC, XIII, etc.). You may bring your own games, computers, gaming systems and TVs as you see fit, but you will be responsible for whatever you bring. Some games are not appropriate for this scouting event. Inappropriateness is the judgment of Mr Weir or Mr Hepfner and include but are not limited to any game in which you are encouraged to break the law or hurt "good" people (Grand Theft Auto would be an example of an inappropriate game).

FUNDS REQUIRED: This event costs \$10.00 for all participants regardless of how long you will be there. Money from your scout account may be used to pay for this event upon written request from you and a parent (SEE BELOW).

REQUIREMENTS: NO SCOUT will be permitted to attend this event unless he has completed the following:

1. Paid his dues to date.
2. Has a completed/signed medical examination on file with the troop (a physical is not required, just a medical information sheet filled out)
3. Paid his \$10.00 event fee.
4. Has his Rank Board mounted on the TROOP RANK BOARD.

GEAR: Since we will be indoors, the boys should dress appropriately, scout t-shirts are encouraged. The boys should also bring a bedroll and toiletries (toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
